

The history concludes with the election of Prime Minister Edward Seaga. The history includes the brief Spanish period, the occupation by the British, the introduction of slavery and sugar during the 1600s and the 1700s, the British Crown Colony, and independence from 1962 to 1980. The history includes Jamaica's interaction with the rest of the world, and Jamaica's contribution to the West.For those visiting Jamaica on a beach vacation, this is a nice little read.
