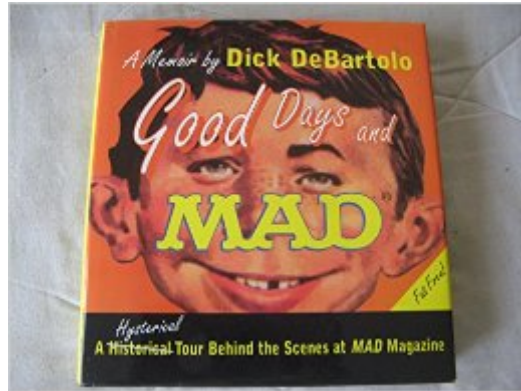

Many, many years later as an adult, I was very interested on how these guys could make this magazine so funny time after time and hear the 'real' stories told from adult to another. Some of the reviews of this book are undeserved and much too harsh in my opinion. The author shares experiences at MAD that left an impression on him and made MAD what it was and what it is.
