

He updates a bit of the interesting content that was contained in the earlier edition of this very readable book. He's now added important updates and if you have not read the book, I suggest you get a

copy.In the update, author McMillan shares his perspective on the expansion of this vital link between Pacific and Atlantic oceans, and the Caribbean Basin; the transformation of the host country (Panama) as American interests were reduced (but not our nation's absolute dependence on the amazing infrastructure);the interest of other economic powers (think: China) in the Isthmus and the canal passage; and throughout, you are informed about the importance of the canal to American political, economic, business, military, and other interests.
